Robert George Yanchury (born George Robert Yanchury on December 5, 1948) died suddenly at home on April 10, 2019, after 70+ years of belly laughs and bad beer (Miller Lite just might go out of business now...).

Bob spent 24 dedicated years serving in the U.S. Army, moving to Minnesota in 1980 as an Army National Guard Recruiter. Always a smooth talker, his best enlistment during that tenure was his wife of 36 years, the Rev. Cindy Yanchury. Aside from career pursuits, Bob was a builder, a painter, a Red Sox, Patriots and avid Lynx fan, and though he'd never admit it, a man rich with brass-tacks wisdom, interesting experiences and poignant insight.
